ARTIST'S LOFT BERGEN / LAFAYETTE


Installation artist Lisa Ariotti creates her numerous paintings in a spacious multilevel loft that was once an old factory building. A rustic structure, it's one of Jersey City's few loft conversions where the interiors remain raw. This feature allows artists to create unique environments well suited to their craft. Musicians can build interior stages, sculptors have high ceilings, even the internal corridors function as gallery space for resident photographers and painters alike.
